Eligibility: The applicant should have Master's degree in health (including medicine and public health) or social sciences, management, public/business administration, population, development studies; five years of progressively responsible professional working experience (with GoN system, I/NGOs, CBOs) at district and community level in planning, management, monitoring and evaluation in the areas of gender, social inclusion, human rights, research, training, facilitation; good understanding of complex socio-cultural issues; technical cooperation in reproductive health, gender, population and development and humanitarian assistance programmes.
